

Reread lines 46-58 of *Eclogue One*. Draw and/or colour a picture of Meliboeus' description of Tityrus based as closely as possible on the Latin text that you have read. Then label each element of the picture with the **Latin dictionary entry** of each thing depicted. Try to include as many elements and words as you can. I do realize that the gods have not distributed artistic talent equally but do your best to imagine Tityrus in his pastoral world and depict it accurately. You are also encouraged to incorporate other elements from the poem into your picture. It is crucial that you show visually a detailed understanding of the text and label each element with Latin dictionary entries and phrases. I will also give extra credit for artistic brilliance, cleverness and creativity. You should use other paper. Value 100 Points. Due Wednesday, February 17.
